**Meiji: Japan Rediscovered** explores the vibrant connection between Japan and the West during the Meiji period, when Japanese artists re-discovered their own history in response to the “opening” of the country.

**Through the Colonial Lens: Photographs of 19th and 20th Century India** provides a critical look at the impact of colonialism through the introduction of photography in India.

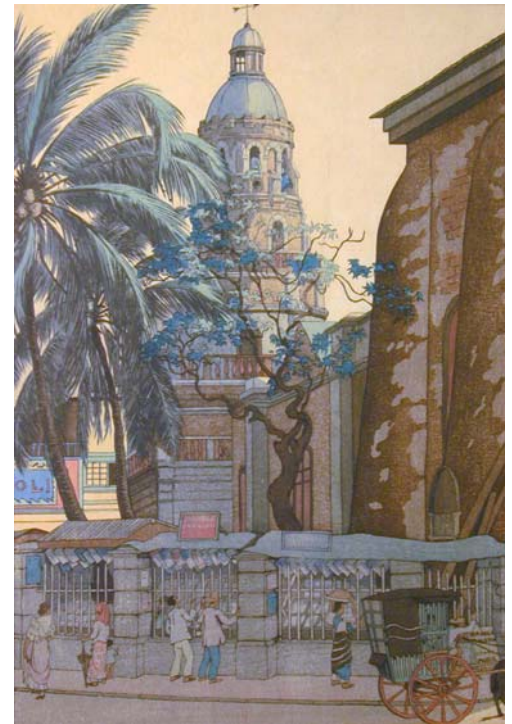


Image by Elizabeth Keith (1887-1956), *Manila Cathedral*, China, 1920s, woodblock print.
